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How to most effectively use the "5-Day-A-Week" Scripture Mastery Worksheet:

To help your students truly learn the Scripture Mastery scriptures, it is best that you spend a few minutes each day learning them. Most teachers have found that it is best to spotlight one Mastery passage a week. This worksheet will help you know what to do each day with that particular scripture. You can make a copy of this worksheet for each student, <u>OR there is another worksheet where you only give a strip of paper that has the passage for that week</u>. Some teachers don't use the actual worksheet but use the method and pattern for each week.

Since the first semester Assessment test is based on the first twelve scripture masteries, and the second semester is based on the last thirteen, it probably is best to focus on them by semester. For that reason the worksheet is divided by semester.

In the end, this worksheet is to help you and your students with:

- Memorizing the passages
- Locating the verses by knowing the associated key words and scripture references
- Understanding the context and content of the scripture passages
- Applying the gospel principles and doctrines taught in the scripture passages

The grayed portion at the top of each page gives you an idea what to do. Each seminary day you should recite the passage together, out loud as a class. Then do the other instructions under "Day 1" through "Day 5". By the end of the week your class should be ready to pass off the Mastery scripture to a fellow classmate or to you. Here is how your week might go:

DAY 1: Recite the scripture together as a class. They can look at the handout or you could have the scripture written out on a chalk board. Some teachers order bigger posters if they have the budget for it. See www.carrprinting.com. Then I ask my class, "What is so special about this scripture that they decided to make it a Scripture Mastery?" Then we also go over the back of the Scripture Mastery Card for that passage and discuss the Context, Doctrine or Principle, and Application. About 5 minutes.

Day 2: Recite the passage again like the day before and then learn the mnemonic cartoon. You can refer them to the handout or print out that particular mnemonic you are spotlighting that week, and have it up front. To teach mnemonics properly, see the instructions on the first page of the mnemonics handout. Then I like to do a simple scripture chase activity with that passage and any we have learned previously. Simple say the key words and then say, "Chase!" and they have to remember the reference, and find it in their scriptures. Don't let the class tell each other the reference, but rather, give clues based on the mnemonic.

Day 3: Recite the passage again and then have them see if they can recite it using the fill-in-the blanks on the worksheet. Also ask the class to try to figure out as many doctrines and principles they can from the passage. Ask them what kind of situations they could come up where knowing that scripture could help.

Day 4: Recite the passage together again and then ask them to recite it using the first letters of each word like on the worksheet. Then come up with a role play situation where that scripture would be useful and have them act it out and share that scripture with the other person. Roleplaying is great practice for a mission.

Day 5: Recite the passage all together again and then give them a few minutes to pass it off to you or a classmate. I like to have an Incentive chart where they put a sticker down when they have passed off the particular scripture. Some stakes have the standard of only two hints on the harder scriptures when passing it off. They also say you can use the first letter of each word to pass off the 2 longest Scripture Mastery passages.

Tips for Memorizing: Many students claim "I just can't memorize" and schools now days do not encourage memorizing much. But those students will often succeed with some small adjustments:

- Instead of spotlighting and passing off the Scripture Masteries in chronological order, try doing the smallest Scripture Masteries first. On the worksheet, to the far right of each scripture mastery you will see a number that indicates smallest to biggest for that semester. As they pass them off in order of size, you may see them gaining more confidence in their abilities to memorize.
- Make an incentive chart with students' names listed down and the scripture mastery references the other way. As they pass off the passage, have them color in the square or put a sticker there.
- Let them have no more than two helps when passing off a memorized scripture.
- With the longest scriptures, you may want to have them pass it off in parts and take more than one week to learn it. You could also let them use the first letters of each word for passing of the 2 longest scripture masteries.
